## Visit by International President Brian Sheehan and spouse Lion Lori to Singapore, 1-3 December 2022

International President Brian Sheehan and Lady Lori Sheehan were in Singapore 1-3 December arriving from Manila after attending OSEAL in Jeju, South Korea.

They were received by 40 Lions at Changi Airport headed by District Governor SK Ho, and all proceeded to the newly opened JiaHe Grand Restaurant for the Welcome Fellowship Dinner organised by OC PDG Bobby Eng.

86 Lions were waiting at One Farrer Hotel and together we had a fabulous time singing and dancing with live music arranged by DC Loh Yan Poh. He and DG SK accompanied IP Brian on stage to sing "Can't Buy Me Love".

There were speeches and exchange of gifts. MC was Cabinet Secretary Jenny Tan.

The LCI visitors' hotel accommodation in MBS was by courtesy of PID Charlie Chan/Dora Chan. As ADC PID Dr. Naga fell ill in Manila and could not come to Singapore, DG SK Ho became IP's ADC.

The visit to Lions Home For The Elders was organised on 2nd December at 10am. IP Brian and Lori were very impressed after their tour and very proud that Singapore Lions have such a well-organised facility for seniors.

Lunch was at Kam Boat arranged for the Heads of Lions Entities. There was an impromptu Dialogue Session:

- PDG Eric Ng commented about LCI consensus on one-member Clubs;

- PDG Irene Tan asked about the correctness of MDCC order of precedence;

- PCC Winston Koh asked about emphasis on climate change in Environment and relevance of Hunger Relief coinage in cosmopolitan Singapore; and

- PDG Isabel Cheong wanted to know LCI's stand on quality vs quantity of membership.

After lunch was a visit to Lions Befrienders Service Association in Mei Ling Street Active Aging Centre. Chairman of LB PDG Anthony Tay and Board Members, Executive Director Karen Wee as well as Centre staff put up a very good show for the visiting dignitaries including the unveiling of a wall plaque and health testing for them.

## My 2<sup>nd</sup> District Goal is Service Excellence

What is Service?

- An Act of Kindness
- Assistance to Others
- Categories of Work

"We Serve" is the Lions Motto and Lions provide services all the time as Where There's A Need, There's A Lion.

Every Lions Club has administrative service to handle and manage. Secretarial Services by Club Secretary and Accounting Services by Club Treasurer are of paramount importance and must be done properly and promptly to be of excellence in Club Administration. There are Fund Raising Service Projects whereby financial governance and charity compliance must be strictly adhered to before being considered good or of excellent standard in Club performance.

Club's Service Excellence include:

- 1) Monthly Board of Directors' Meeting.
- 2) Periodic General Members' Meeting which is the supreme deciding body of the Club.
- 3) Attendance at District Governor's Quarterly Advisory Meetings by the required Officers.
- 4) Timely reporting of MMR and MSR.
- 5) Timely submission of PU101.
- 6) Timely collection of members' Dues and payment of LCI Dues.
- 7) Membership Chairman's important and effective role of recruitment and retention.
- 8) Proper inventory control and foster members' welfare by Tamer.
- 9) Club Service Chairman's efficient management of service projects,
- 10) Club Marketing Communications Coordinator's proficiency in public relations, portraying Club image and branding for Lionism.
- 11) Club LCIF Coordinator in promoting LCIF Goals and seeking for Melvin Jones Fellows from members and friends.
- 12) Nominations Committee Chairman appointed by Club President to handle the proper elections of next year's office bearers at AGM.
- 13) Visits to Twin Clubs, if any.
- 14) Guidance to Leo Clubs, if any.
- 15) Constant support of sponsored Clubs, if any.

16) Appreciation & Awards Night by out-going Club President and the Installation of the new BOD.

Club's Service Excellence will also include having members being appointed into the District Cabinet, and if elected into the Management Boards of Lions Entities.

However, sometimes this area may be ignored or neglected. For example, punctuality and obligatory attendance at the quarterly Cabinet Meetings or the monthly MB Meetings when Club BOD is not aware of their member's absence.

These Club members' value-added contributions and relevant reports as Cabinet Officer or as Board Director or as Sub-Committee Chairman reflect the Club's Service Excellence too.

Truly understanding Lions Purposes and upholding the Lions Code of Ethics at all times are the basic tenets if we want to provide excellent service as Lions.

- 6) 会员主席有效地招募和保留会员。
- 7) 适当的库存管控并通过总务(Tamer)促进会员福利。
- 8) 分会服务主席对服务项目的高效管理,
- 9) 分会营销传播协调员熟练公共关系、展示分会形象和狮子会品牌。
- 10) 狮子会国际基金会(LCIF)分会协调员,负责宣传 LCIF 目标并从会员和朋友那里为茂钟文基金筹募款项 (Melvin Jones Fellow)。
- 11) 拜访姐妹会, 如果有的话。
- 12) 督导青少狮子会,如果有的话。
- 13) 支持协助所发起的分会,如果有的话。

14) 分会会长指定选委会提名主席进行妥当选举出下一屆理事会。 15) 及时提交分会新理事成员名单(PU101)。

16) 即将离任的分会会长举办感谢和颁奖仪式及新理事交接典礼。

分会卓越活动包括狮友们受委为分区内阁成员与被选进入狮子会相关 附属机构的理事。

但是,有时这方面可能被忽略。

例如,分会理事会不知道其会员缺席,是因为义务並准时出席了 308-A1 区内阁季度会议或相关附属机构的每月理事会会议。

#### Review of Cabinet Performance in Q1, 2022/23 Term of Office By ZC Lion Jonathan Tan

District Governor SK Ho hosted two Fellowship Dinners, on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> October 2022, for his Cabinet Officers and MDCC (to suit their availability) as part of our District's 1st Quarterly Appraisal Review. The dinners were held at Imperial Grand Cantonese Cuisine Restaurant which are owned by fellow-Lions from LCS Fort Canning and LCS Beverly Hills.

I attended the dinner on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> October. It was a very informal evening with DG starting off with a brief overview of our performance over the past three months. The mood was relaxed as the Cabinet Officers introduced themselves and briefly talked about their performances. The dinner was entertained by karaoke singing, while the occasional dancing created an atmosphere of delight and camaraderie.

DG informed the audience that, over the first quarter of his term of office, 48 Clubs had no members joining and leaving their Clubs, while 83 Clubs had full retention of their existing members. He said that the most significant statistic was that our District had a nett growth of 302 members. Total number of Lions in District 308A1 was 2,870 as at 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

The various interest groups have somewhat unified the District and we all looked forward to a successful LCS65 Carnival in March 2023.

We all took notice of our shortfalls and assured ourselves to improve in the next three quarters to serve with commitment and gusto under the capable and creative leadership DG SK Ho.

# Reflections and Feedback by Cabinet Officers during Q1, 2022/23

(Compiled by DG SK Ho)

# 1. What's the future for Lionism (volunteerism & philanthropy) in Singapore?

i. When Lions care about specific causes in their communities, they come together to find ways to resolve them, all their resources are pooled together to initiate innovative ways to work for the benefit of those around them. Their compassion and empathy are combined in service of shared goals, with egos set aside. While we might not think this is true, a crisis like Covid-19 shows that Lions do care and act.

ii. To prepare for future challenges in the Lions landscape and create a future in what we serve, we need to understand where the seeds of that future are in the present. These will shape how we act on what, when and why we serve.

- iii. Let's be mindful of the following:
- The ageing population in Singapore
- Rise of naturalised citizens
- Millennials and Gen Z as future leaders
- Inequalities in society
- Sustainability
- Digital Revolution
- Fake news and misinformation
- Infiltration of Bio-Technology and AI

iv. Volunteerism is quite active in Singapore, and I believe that there will always be a place for Lionism as long as there are needs within the community that need to be met. But the longevity of Lionism really depends on our ability to constantly reinvent ourselves and adapt to the changes in society. v. In the past two years (perhaps also forced upon us by the pandemic to do things differently), the emergence of Lions interest groups has definitely added colour and life to the whole movement. Besides encouraging bonding and fellowship, interest groups have also resulted in new and creative service projects being introduced into the District (e.g.: bake-in, zoomaroke), which have in turn, attracted a new and more diverse group of people joining the Lions movement. There are a few very active young and (relatively) new Lions whom we have seen emerging in recent months, and all of them first started out being active in the various interest groups that were set up even before the pandemic struck.

# 2. How can we improve the standing and image branding of Lions in Singapore?

i. Lions have partnered with private and public sectors but we are not prominent in the public's eyes. We need to share constantly the good work that we do via social media and involve partners to do a shout-out for us.

ii. When there is a need to build equipment or provide fixtures for the beneficiaries, we should explore having the Lions logo installed or placed at locations with high visibility.

iii. Perhaps to create our own Lions mascot at the L65 Carnival and let this be the showcase at Lions events and activities in future to have our presence felt and remembered.

iv. I believe that improvement of brand image first begins within the movement itself. If new members come into the Clubs and they have a positive experience helping the community and engaging in volunteerism, they would, in turn, encourage more people in their social circles to join in and participate. However, if a member were to leave disillusioned by internal politics, then the image of Lionism as a whole would definitely be affected as well.

v. To improve the standing and brand image of Lionism, it is also important that we look at the various opportunities and touch-points that we have with our members and the community. I recently attended the New Members Orientation in August together with some of the new members from my Club. For me, having been a Lion for some time, it was an insightful presentation of the history and significance of Lions International and the various entities that we serve in. However, for a new member who has zero knowledge of our structure and entities, it can be too much information for them. A District Orientation session is actually a very good opportunity for new members to interact with members from other Clubs and senior Lions in the District, hence, a more interactive session featuring the various community and service projects that we are involved would be beneficial.

# 3. How do you see our District in 5 years' time after we are redistricted and chartered as "District 309"?

i. During the initial phase, there will be differences in terms of leadership and contest for Council Chairman.

ii. I hope our District will maintain as one rather than split. We should work in harmony by sharing resources, and focus on common causes to better our service. With harmony, we are able to promote Lions image and bring positive vibes to the community to draw more members.

iii. I see redistricting as an opportunity for us to work more closely together in Singapore. It's really what we make of it. As a new independent District, issues like image and branding become all the more relevant, both within the Lions movement itself and in the Community.

iv. A lot of the fruits that we see in the first three months of our term are the result of years of effort and hard work which you have put in to set up opportunities for us to enjoy fellowship together via the interest groups, and getting to know us better as people, way before you even announced that you were running for 2VDG. I also see the effort that you put in to remain actively involved on the ground, even as DG.

v. Generally, I feel that it has been a good start due to the foundations that have been set in place and we should move on and work together to continue and end the year well.

### 2022/23 年第一季度內阁成员表现检讨

# 2022/23 年第一季度区内阁成员的反思反馈 (区总监何沁光编辑)

1. "新加坡狮子会(志愿服务和慈善事业)将来会是什么样?"

- 当狮友关心社区中的具体因素时,他们会聚在一起寻找解决问题的方法,汇集他们的资源,用创新方式来为周围的人谋福利。同情心和同理心结合在一起,为共同的目标服务努力,而将自我意识放一边。

虽然我们可能认为这不是真实的,但冠状疫情之下,狮友们确实体现 关心并采取行动。

- 为了接受将来临的挑战与创造我们的未来服务,我们需要了解这些各种要素。这将让我们营造合时、服务方式、目的明确的行动。

- 我们应关注以下几点:

- 人口老龄化

- 新公民归化

- 千禧一代和Z世代成为未来的领导者

- 社会不平等
- 可持续方案
- 数码革新

-假新闻与错误讯息传播

- 生物科技和人工智能开展

- 志愿服务在新加坡非常活跃,我相信只要社区里有需求,狮子会运动总会有一席之地。

但狮子会运动的延续取决于我们不断改进自己和适应社会变化的能力。

- 在过去的两年里(也许是冠状疫情迫使我们采取不同的做法),

狮友兴趣小组的出现无疑为整个运动增添了许多色彩和活力。

除了增强与建立团契联谊外,兴趣小组还促成了新颖和创造性的服务 项目被引入我区(例如:烘焙、Zoom卡拉

OK),这反过来又吸引了一批新会员和来自不同背景的人加入狮子会运动。最近几个月,我们看到有一些非常活跃的年轻人(相对的)和新狮友的出现。他们在冠狀疫情开始之前就已经活跃于已经建立起的各个兴趣小组中。

2. "我们如何提高狮友在新加坡的地位和形象品牌?"

- 狮子会与私营和公共机构合作,但我们在公共领域并不突出。我 们需要通过社交媒体不断分享我们的诚意,并让合作伙伴为我们大力 推荐。

- 当需要为受益人建造设备或提供固定装置时,我们应该探讨在明显可見地方安装或放置狮子会的标志。

- 或许,可以在LCS65 嘉年华上制作我们自己的狮子会吉祥物, 并让它成为未来狮子会活动的标志,让大家认同,感受并记住它。

- 我相信品牌形象的提升,首先要从运动本身开始。

如果新成员加入分会后,他们在帮助社区和参与志愿服务方面有积极 的经历,将能鼓励他们社交圈子里更多的人加入和参与。

但是,反过來如果一个会员被内部人事政治化被幻灭,那么狮子会的 整体形象肯定也会受到影响。

- 为了提高狮子会运动的地位和品牌形象,我们还必须关注我们与 会员和社区的各种机会和接触点。

我最近和分会的一些新会员一起参加了八月份的迎新会员讲习班。

对我来说,在狮子会工作了一段时间,了解到这是对国际狮子会的历 史和意义以及我们所服务的各个相关附属机构深刻的介绍。然而,对 于一个新会员来说,可能会是太多的信息。

• Topic 1: "Cornea Donation in Singapore", was presented by Dr. Howard Cajucom-Uy (Assistant Director, Singapore Eye Bank, SNEC)

• Topic 2: "Glaucoma and its management - what you need to know", was presented by Dr. Low Jin Rong (Consultant, Glaucoma Department, Singapore National Eye Centre)

The topic covered in the Zoom webinar on 8th October 2022, attended by an audience of 112, was on "Glaucoma and its Management" which was presented in Mandarin language by Dr. Low Jin Rong (Consultant, Glaucoma Department, Singapore National Eye Centre).

The topics covered for the Zoom webinar on 15th October 2022 attended, by an audience of 160, were:

• Topic 1: "The Sun & the Ocular Surface: Cornea Conditions & Pterygium and their management ", was presented by Dr. Ong Hon Sing (Consultant Corneal & External Eye Disease Department, SNEC)
